However, we are looking for a high school that is interested in a new peer suicide prevention program. **Teen Mental Health First Aid** is an evidence based, universal level curriculum for 10-12th grade students. Why use this curriculum over other options out there? Although most evidence-based programs (such as Signs of Suicide SOS or QPR) have shown reduction in suicidal ideations and attempts they do not necessarily promote help seeking behaviors. Additionally, this program covers a wide umbrella of mental health literacy. It mirrors the language used in Youth Mental Health First Aid so your students,

The Fine Print:

- All the grade level must receive the training. We recommend targeting 10th grade over the course of a year

- Classes are either six 45-minute sessions or three 90-minute sessions
- 10% of staff need to be trained in Youth Mental Health First Aid (also free, if needed)
